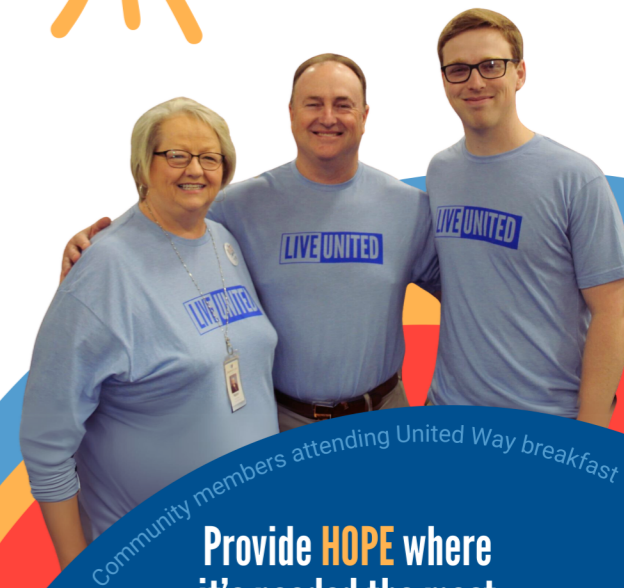

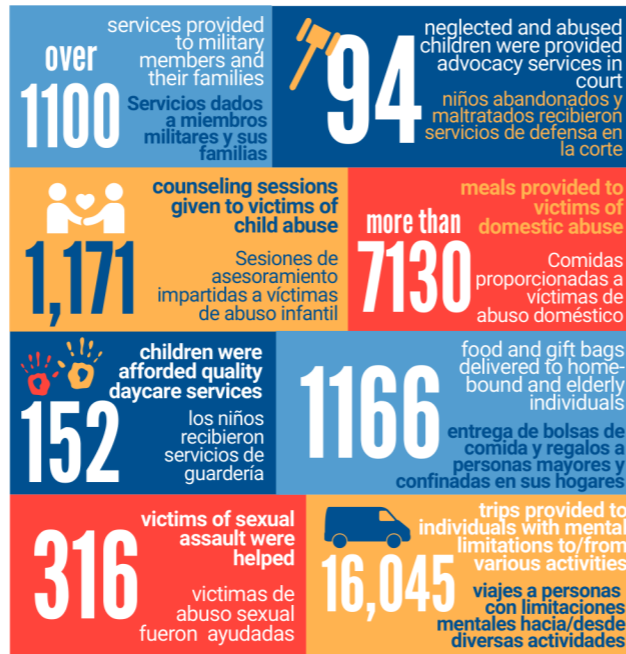

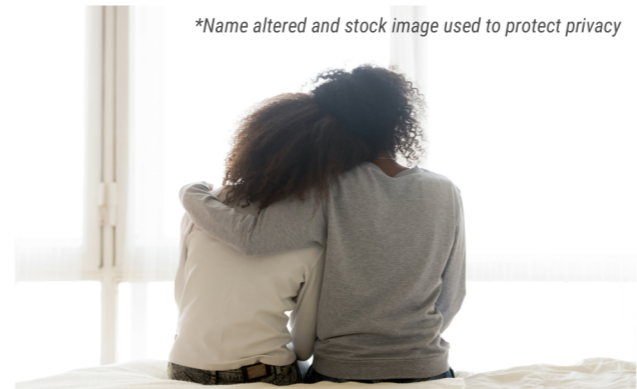

Real-Life Success through United Way

BREAKING THE SILENCE

In the quiet hours of the night, the on-call forensic interviewer at the Child Advocacy Center (CAC) met with law enforcement and the Department of Human Resources (DHR) to interview a brave teenage girl who had made a heartbreaking disclosure. For years, she had suffered in silence, enduring sexual abuse from her teenage brother and her father. The details shared by the victim enabled law enforcement to secure critical evidence, leading to the immediate arrest of both offenders and removing her from a horrendous situation.

The young victim began her journey to healing through therapy services provided by the CAC. Her progress was remarkable, demonstrating the resilience of the human spirit and the power of support from a dedicated community. The multidisciplinary team effort in Marshall County, including the DA's Office, juvenile probation, and the United Way's partner agency, played a crucial role in her recovery and the pursuit of justice.



The law enforcement investigator used information from the forensic interview to guide officers in collecting vital evidence from the home. This evidence was instrumental in securing guilty verdicts against the father, resulting in a life sentence without parole. The brother was transferred to a juvenile sex offender treatment facility, ensuring he would receive the help he needed.

The young girl continued therapy until she moved out of state. She returned to testify at the trial. This story highlights the extraordinary impact of collaboration, demonstrating the essential role of United Way and its partner agencies in transforming lives and bringing hope to those in need in Marshall County.
